Now Hiring: Queen's Genetically Engineered Machine (QGEM) Team Executive Member

The QGEM Team is currently hiring several new executive members for 2012. If hired onto the team, the executive will work independently and with the rest of the team to prepare the team working in summer 2012.

The executive committee will be working to recruit team members for paid and volunteer summer positions with the team, and working to gain greater Queen's faculty involvement with the team. Once the summer team is hired, the executive committee will work to train and prepare the lab team for work in the summer. *Please note that becoming an executive team member does not exclude you from applying to work on the team for summer 2012. The committee will also be working to gain sponsorship to help run this team this summer.

The hired executive member will be responsible for attending a team meeting once per week with other exec members. They are also expected to work promptly towards completing the tasks set to the subcommittee in which they a member.

Job Description:

Sponsorship Committee Member:

- -Do research on potential sponsorship sources
- -Call, email and interact with companies to try and gain sponsorship
- -Apply for Queen's based funding
- -Campaign for the establishment of a QGEM opt-outable fee

Recruitment Committee Member:

- -Design and carry out a recruitment campaign
- -Go into Queen's classes before they start and give short speeches about QGEM
- -Hold IGEM introduction session for people interested in being involved with the team this summer
- -Approach Queen's faculty members about potentially being involved with the team.

Hiring Committee Member*:

- -Evaluate student applications for summer work with the team
- -Interview top applicants
- -Aid in the selection of team members
 - *If you become a member of this committee, you will **not be eligible to** apply for a paid summer position with the team.

Education Committee Member:

- -Hold information sessions for people interested in being involved with the team this summer
- -Teach the summer team members about molecular biology, and synthetic biology
- -Please note that no prior knowledge is required to sit on this committee
